THE ADVANCED WORKSHOP: JUNE 14 - JULY 2, AGES 15 - 21

This Joffrey South Workshop offers advanced students ages 15-21 a three-week, in-depth ballet experience. Daily technique will be offered in ballet, pointe, variations, and new choreography. On the final day of the program students will perform in a demonstration on the stage at Russell Auditorium. Students attending this Joffrey South Workshop will be considered for enrollment in the Joffrey Ballet School's year-long program in New York City.

THE EXTENDED INTERMEDIATE WORKSHOP: JUNE 19 - JULY 2, AGES 11 - 14 OR THE INTERMEDIATE WORKSHOP: JULY 5 - 11, AGES 11 - 14

Young aspiring dance students, ages 11-14, have the opportunity to attend either a one-week or nine-day intensive ballet workshop. This is a wonderful introduction to summer dance away from the familiarity of the student's home studio. Students participate in six or nine days of ballet, pointe, and variations, augmented with a foot care seminar, history of ballet, and other dance related classes. This workshop will culminate in a student demonstration on the final day.

JOFFREY LIGHT WORKSHOP: JUNE 12 - 14, AGES 9 - 11

Joffrey Light, new in 2008, is our way of giving the young dance student a taste of the intensive routine while only spending two nights away from home. This long weekend will be filled with the same classes the older students take but will be just long enough to whet the appetite for the Joffrey Intermediate. No audition is required, but space is limited.

WELCOME TO HISTORIC MILLEDGEVILLE...

Step back in time to the antebellum capital of Georgia. Milledgeville was the political center of Georgia from 1803 to 1868, when the capital was moved to Atlanta. Modeled after Savannah, Georgia, and Washington, D.C., the city is home to many historic downtown buildings: the Old State Capitol (1807), the John Marlor Arts Center (1830), Sacred Heart Catholic Church (1874), and many other sites and homes that date from the early 1800's, including Memory Hill Cemetery. A short drive from downtown is Lockerly Arboretum, a forty-five acre site ideal for picnics and afternoon walks.

...AND GEORGIA COLLEGE & STATE UNIVERSITY

Located in the heart of the state, Georgia College & State University is approximately 100 miles from Atlanta, Augusta, Albany, and Columbus, and 30 miles from Macon. It is approximately 40 miles from I-75, I-16, and I-20.

ACCOMMODATIONS, LODGING, AND CHAPERONES

Resident campers will live two to a room in our suite-style residence halls, conveniently located within walking distance of classes and activities. A single lavatory is shared between every two rooms (four students). All rooms and community areas are air-conditioned. Meals will be provided by the university. Qualified GCSU employees will chaperone all program participants. GCSU has recently been rated one of the safest universities in the nation.

Audition applications are available on our website. Bring the completed application and the \$30 audition fee (cash only) with you to the audition location of your choice. Prior registration is not required.

A 5x7 full-body photograph of the dancer posed in first arabesque is required at the audition. Ladies must wear a black leotard, pink tights, and bring pointe shoes. Gentlemen must wear black tights, white t-shirt, white socks, and shoes.

Students who are unable to attend the audition may apply by submitting a video tape which should begin with a short technical demonstration at the barre and in the center. This section should be less than five minutes in length. A solo of a classical variation (on pointe for women), one to two minutes in length, should also be included.
